2-hour Urgent Community Response (UCR) (Southport and Formby ICRAS Team)

Do you know Mersey Care NHS Trust has teams of advanced clinicians working in the community who can respond within two hours if someone's health or wellbeing suddenly deteriorates at home?

This can avoid the need for an ambulance and prevent hospital admission.

Do you know your UCR team?



Advanced nurses and therapists can carry out assessments, order tests, diagnose, prescribe and order equipment within two hours of referral. The service will be operational 8am to 8pm 7 days a week. The last referral accepted by the service will be at 7pm.

The UCR team can keep the patient safe at home with the support of GPs, geriatricians, social care and other specialists

What conditions are suitable for referral to your UCR team?

If you think the patient could be admitted to hospital unless they are seen within two hours, call your UCR team. Here's a list of the most probable scenarios:



- Decompensation of frailty
- Reduced function/
- deconditioning/reduced mobility

(where core services not available)

- Confusion/delirium Fall with no apparent serious injury
 - · Urgent catheter care
 - Urgent support for diabetes
- Unpaid carer breakdown which if not Palliative/end of life care crisis support resolved will result in a health care crisis
 - Urgent equipment provision

How can you make a referral?



The UCR teams are being rolled out across the Trust and with effect from 1 April 2022 the service in Southport and Formby will be operational and able to support you with improving patient experiences and outcomes.

Here are some ways that may help:

• Ensure you are receiving all the benefits you are entitled to. Many support services such as welfare rights, citizens advice and www.gov.uk may be able to assist with this. Sefton Councils Welfare Rights team can be contacted on **0151 934 3660** or email Welfarerights.advice@sefton.gov.uk

Speak to your energy supplier

- You may qualify for Warm Homes Discount (£140 towards energy costs)
- Ask about smart meters they help you to monitor energy usage in your home, which may help you to
- They may be able to help with debt and manageable repayment plans

United Utilities Help

- Could you save on a water meter? If you have more bedrooms than people living at the property you are likely to save money. You can trial a water meter for 2 years to see if it benefits you. Call United Utilities on 0345 072 6065 or visit United Utilities - Apply for water meter
- Struggling to pay your water bill contact 0800 072 6765 or visit United Utilities - How we can help with your bill

Does your property need insulation?

Insulation helps to keep the heat in your home, meaning you use less energy. You may qualify for funding. Contact the Retrofit team **0151 934 2848** or visit *Green Homes Grant Local Delivery* Scheme (sefton.gov.uk)

- Small energy saving measures can also help to reduce fuel bills such as LED bulbs, radiator reflector panels and easy fit draught proofing.
- Emergency credit If you are on a pre-payment meter you may qualify for an emergency top up voucher (subject to availability)
- Funding towards heating appliances, if you find yourself in a no heat situation
