There will be free copies of the new Carers Rights Guide available for all carers, as well as information about the services available at the centre. These services include, free advice and guidance, carer's needs assessments, emotional and practical support, training and a range of holistic therapies for unpaid carers living in Sefton.

Carers Rights Day is an annual national awareness campaign organised by the charity Carers UK, which aims to reach as many of the 6.5 million carers in the UK as possible with information about their rights and the financial and practical help they are entitled to; including benefits, such as Carer's Allowance, respite and access to equipment and technology which can help them in their caring role.

John Hill, Development Officer at Sefton Carers Centre, said: "There are currently more than 35,000 carers in Sefton each providing unpaid care for at least one other person who could not manage without this support.

"Therefore, at least 70,000 people in Sefton are either providing care or are dependent upon it for their health and wellbeing, which is almost a third of the resident population. As statistics suggest 60% of us will become carers at some point in our life potentially over 160,000 of Sefton's residents will eventually become carers.

"As no one can know in advance if they will become a carer or need the support of a carer, this is an agenda everyone in Sefton should be concerned about."

Helena Herklots, Chief Executive of Carers UK, said: "No matter where you are on your caring journey – whether you're starting to care for a loved one, have been caring a while, or your caring role has come to an end - it is vital that you are able to get the help and advice you need,

when you need t. No one should have to care alone and Carers Rights Day events like the one being run by Sefton Carers Centre mean that carers don't have to.'
