Young Carers Transitions Service

Sefton Young Carers Transitions supports 16-25 year old carers throughout their caring journey through to adulthood. Personalised support is offered to each individual and focuses on protecting the futures of Sefton's Young Adult Carers. The Young Carers Transitions Project has recently been successful in securing funding for the next 6 months from a grant funded by Carers Trust and Quilter PLC. This new funding will further enhance young carer transitions support and aim to encourage our young carers to work towards their personal goals in education, training and employment.



THE GRANT WILL ALLOW US TO:

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- dedicate additional staff time to offer more personalised support to more carers.
- offer group workshops and sessions facilitated by us and partners around the themes of education, employability and wellbeing.
- create an Aspirations Fund for young adult carers which will incentivise engagement with the service - carers will be rewarded with a financial benefit that will support their continuing education, training or employment.



No matter how much time you have available to volunteer – from a couple of hours a fortnight to a day or two each week - the benefits of volunteering can be enormous. By volunteering, your skills and experiences can help support Carers in Sefton - a little of your time goes a long way!



The Listening Ear Service

A team of volunteers ring Carers who may be feeling isolated, lonely or just simply want to have a chat with a friendly voice. The chats can last from anything from a guick 5 minutes or an hour, its really dependent on the Carers needs and what's happening in their lives that week. The listening ear service has always been popular but throughout the pandemic the demand for the service has grew.

The Sitting Service

Volunteers support Carers by sitting in the home of the person they care for, keeping them company enabling the Carer to have a bit of a break to go do some shopping, go for a walk, go to appointments or just to have a bit of 'me' time. This can be for a few hours per week/ fortnight - No personal care is involved. The sitting service coordinator will try to match a volunteer who has similar interests. Ideally we would like volunteers who can travel throughout the borough.

Both services run Monday to Friday 9am-5pm and full training is provided.
